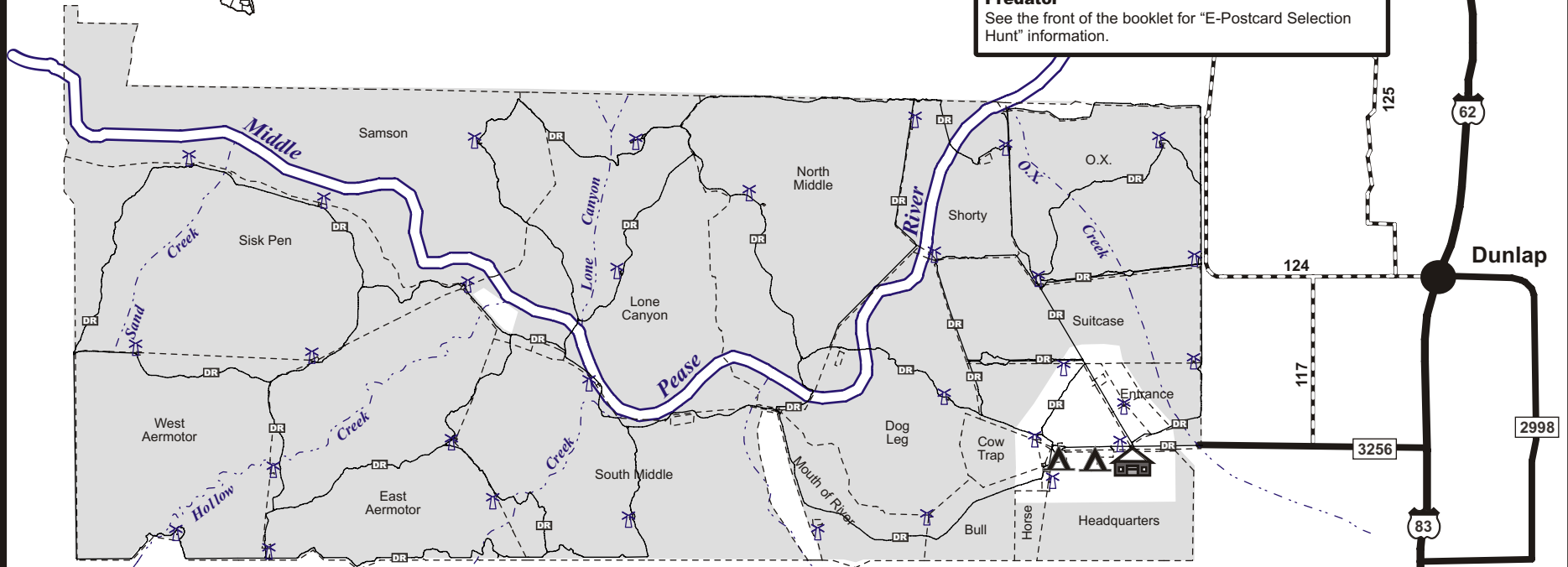

SPECIAL SEASON

Youth/Adult Dove and Quail: Oct. 21-22.
 Each group must contain a youth under age 17 to participate.

LEGAL GAME • 2023-2024

On-site registration is required.

There are **NO DEER HUNTS** by APH Permit on this area.

Dove: Each day of North Zone Dove Season, except dates **ENTIRE AREA CLOSED**.

Quail: Oct. 28-Jan. 31, except dates **ENTIRE AREA CLOSED**.

Duck: Each day of the Early Teal and High Plains Mallard Management Unit seasons except when entire area is closed to hunting.

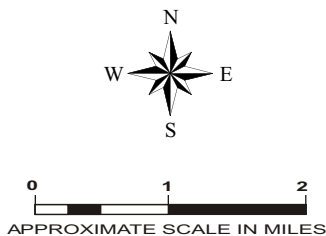
Archery Only Feral Hogs and Coyotes: Mar. 16-24 (no bag limit). Baiting allowed during hunt period only.

Fishing: Allowed every day except on closure dates. Only in Middle Pease River. Pole and line only.

Rabbits & Hares: (Shotgun only) Concurrent with dove and quail dates.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: All vehicle traffic, including ORVs, UTVs, etc., is limited to designated Public Hunting Roads. No hunting within 1/4 mile of campgrounds, residences, and WMA buildings in addition to other restricted areas. All Shotgun hulls and shell boxes must be retrieved from the field and disposed of off the WMA. Horses allowed only during May 20-Aug. 31 and only on designated trails. See Prohibited Acts for regulations on horse use and further restrictions. For more information call the WMA headquarters (806-492-3405).
