

LEGAL GAME • 2023-2024

OSR Required Each Day

Archery Only White-tailed Deer: Sept. 30-Jan. 7 (either sex). Bag limit - 1 buck and 2 antlerless. **LEGAL BUCK** must have at least one unbranched antler or an inside spread of at least 13 inches.

Feral Hogs and Exotic Mammals: Open year-round. Legal means for taking feral hog are: air guns, arrow guns, archery, crossbows, muzzleloaders, and shotguns. Baiting is legal for feral hogs after the last day of waterfowl season until July 31. Dogs are prohibited.

Waterfowl: Shooting hours - one half hour before sunrise to noon.

Early Teal: Hunting is allowed each Tue., Thur., and Sat. during the Early Teal Season

North Zone Duck, Eastern Zone Goose, Falconry, and Light Goose Conservation Order: Hunting is allowed on Tues., Thurs., and Sat. during the season.

Rail and Gallinules: Shooting hours end at noon. Hunting is allowed Tues., Thurs., and Sat. during the season established for these species including Falconry season.

Snipe: Shooting hours end at noon. Hunting is allowed Tues., Thurs., and Sat. during the season.

Woodcock: Each day during regular and Falconry seasons.

Dove: Each day of Central Zone Dove and Falconry Seasons.

Squirrel: Each day of East Texas Squirrel Season.

Rabbit & Hares: Open year round.

Bullfrogs: (daily limit of 25).

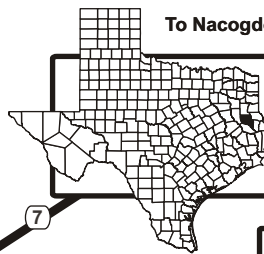

Trapping: Sept. 1-Aug. 31, furbearers and predators only.

Means Restriction: Firearms restricted to shotguns, muzzleloaders, and rimfire only. Non-toxic shot required for all migratory game bird hunting.
