

# ANACUA UNIT, LAS PALOMAS WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

Cameron County

The Anacua Unit consists of 220 acres located approximately 1/2 mile south of Santa Maria south off of US Hwy 281. The unit was originally in farm fields, but now consists primarily of reforested white-winged dove breeding habitat. The unit is divided into two separate sections, with the check station located in the north parking lot. There are designated hunting areas for doves in both the north and south sections of the unit. The closest complete commercial facilities are available in Harlingen. Call the Las Palomas WMA staff for more information (956/501-4793).
