Texas students in grades 4 through 12 are invited to enter the annual **State-Fish Art Contest!**

Contestants must create an illustration of a state fish and write a one-page composition about its behavior, habitat or conservation.

One Texas winner will be selected from each of three grade levels:

- Grades 4-6
- Grades 7-9
- Grades 10-12

Those winners will travel to Minnesota's Mall of America to compete at the national contest for Best of Show and Art of Conservation stamp honors.

Entries must be postmarked by **March 31** to be eligible for judging. Texas entries will be judged at the Texas Freshwater Fisheries Center in Athens. The contest is sponsored by Wildlife Forever.
