

Drive north on I-45. Pass FM 2920/Spring Cypress Road. Take the Spring Stuebner exit. Turn right on Spring Stuebner. Travel through Old Town Spring. Cross the Railroad Tracks at Hardy Road. Continue straight on Spring Stuebner / Riley Fuzzel Road. Cross Spring Creek. Look for the Nature Center entrance on the Right.
