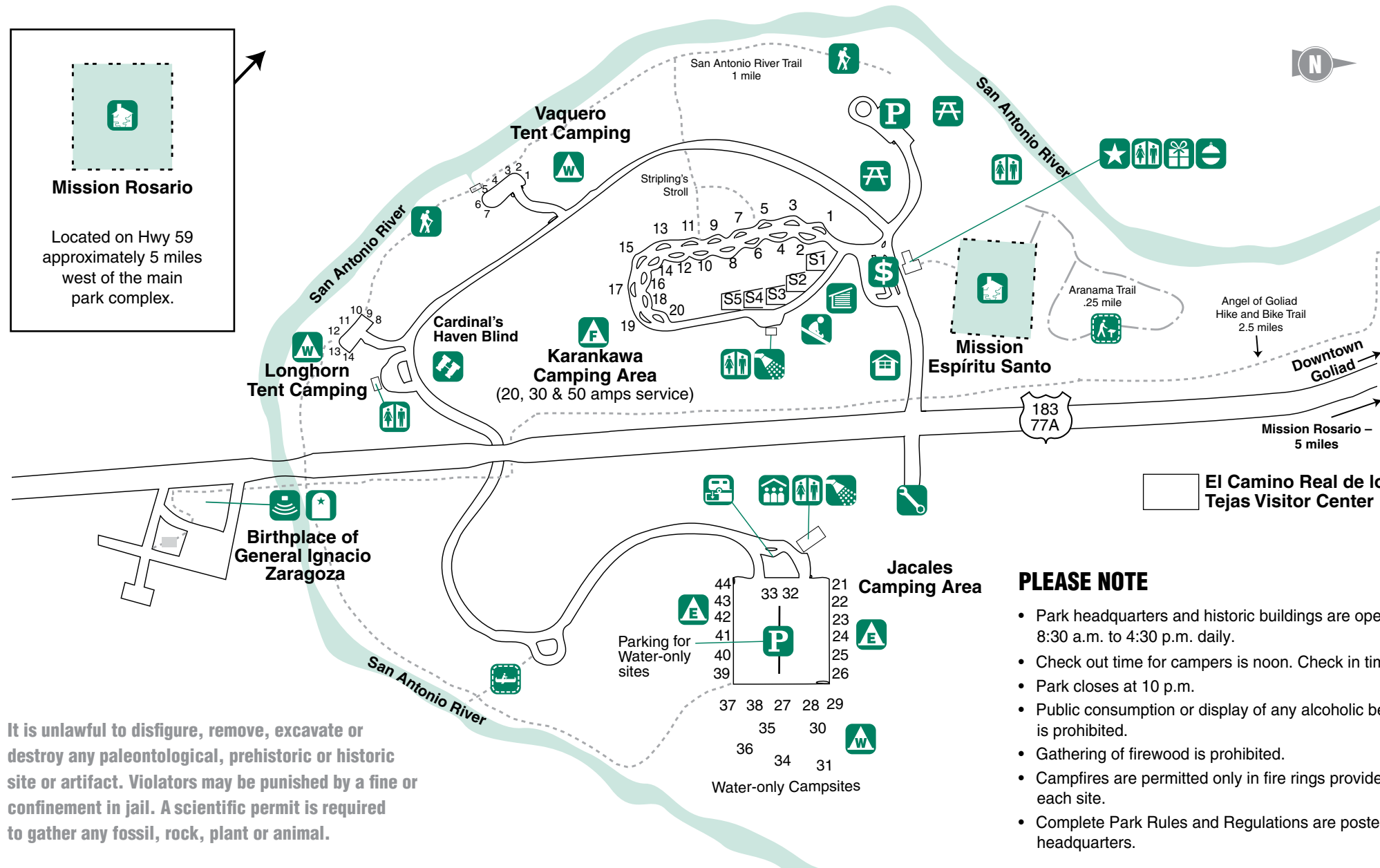

PLEASE NOTE

- Park headquarters and historic buildings are open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily.
- Check out time for campers is noon. Check in time is 2 p.m.
- Park closes at 10 p.m.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided at each site.
- Complete Park Rules and Regulations are posted at headquarters.
