T-shirts, caps and one-of-a-kind gift items are available at the headquarters building.

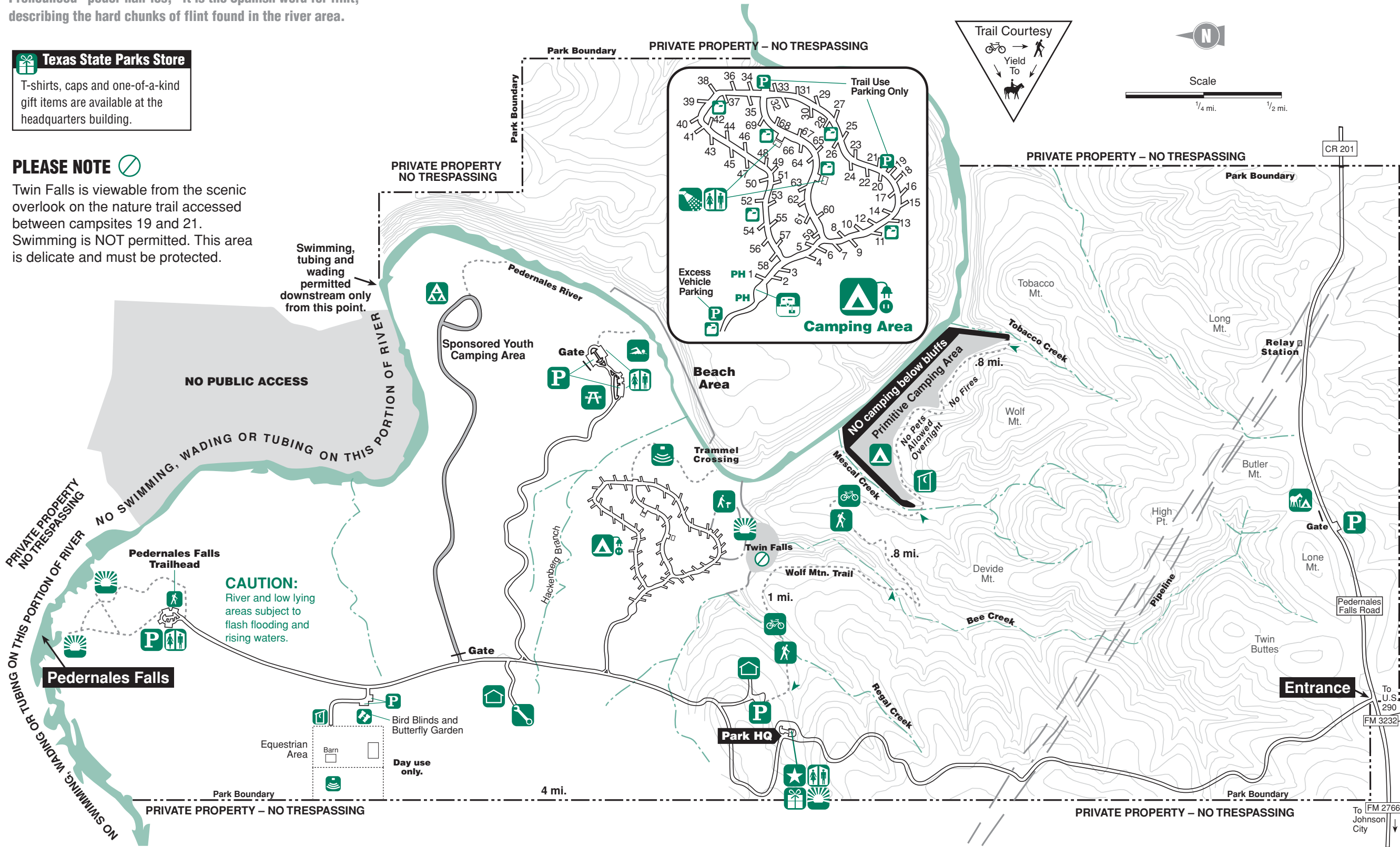
PLEASE NOTE
