The Texas State Park system has traditionally recovered almost half of its yearly operating budget through usage fees. However, the challenge to meet the financial demands of operating a quality park system continues to grow.

To help meet these challenges, elected officials have provided an opportunity for citizens to donate \$5 or more, each time they purchase or renew their vehicle registration. This opt-in program offers a means for local governments to collect these donations and credit the dollars to the state park account. Every cent of your donation goes directly to benefit state parks.
