Lockhart State Park is one of only a few state parks that offers a golf course. Built by the Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930s, the nine-hole course follows the slopes along and above Clear Fork Creek. The CCC also constructed the park's recreational hall, which sits on a bluff above the golf course. During hot summer months, a swimming pool offers a cool escape, and visitors are welcome to cast a fishing line in the creek.



Camping: Campsites with water and electricity or full hookups.



Group Facilities: Group picnic area with tables and grills. Recreation hall for day use or overnight use, with kitchen (capacity 75 people).



Picnicking: Picnic sites with tables and waist-high grills.



Swimming: Swimming pool.




Fishing: Possible catches include bass, catfish and sunfish in Clear Fork Creek.




Golfing: Nine-hole golf course. Golf cart rentals.
