Your purchase supports angler education for youth and adults, fish stocking, and habitat restoration.

A valid fishing license is required for people ages 17 and older to take fish, mussels, clams, crayfish or other aquatic life in the public waters of Texas.

Protect fish and fish habitats:

- Use barbless or circle hooks.
- Play and land the fish quickly.
- Use wet hands to handle the fish.
- Properly dispose of litter and recycle fishing line.
- Dump unused bait in trash or on land far removed from the water. Do not return to the water.

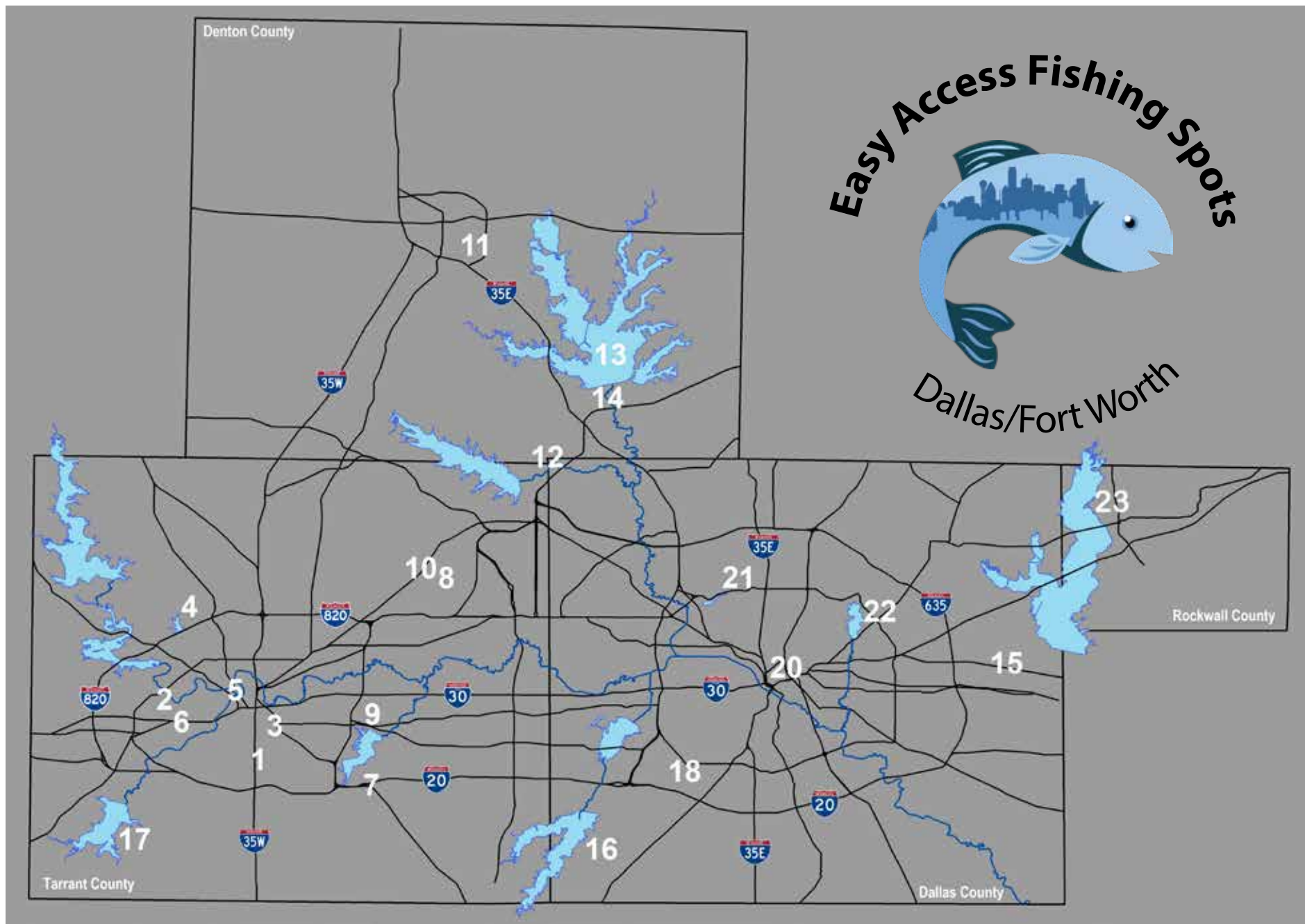

1. Greenbriar Park, Fort Worth

- Neighborhood Fishin' pond.
- Fish for catfish and rainbow trout.

2. Lake Como, Fort Worth

- Abundant bank access.
- Park has picnic tables, a playground, a pavilion, and a fishing pier.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish, catch-and-release recommended.

3. Echo Lake, Fort Worth

- Abundant bank access.
- Park has a playground.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish, catch-and-release recommended.

4. Marine Creek, Fort Worth

- Major reservoir with excellent bank access.
- Walking/exercise trail encompasses lake.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish.

5. Trinity Park, Fort Worth

- Abundant bank access.
- Park has picnic tables, restrooms, a playground, and walking trail.
- Catch-and-release recommended for all species except rainbow trout stocked in winter.

6. River Park, Fort Worth

- Abundant bank access.
- Park has walking trail; no other facilities.
- Catch-and-release recommended for all species except rainbow trout stocked in winter.

7. Sonora Park, Kennedale

- Excellent bank access.
- Park has picnic tables, walking trail, splash park, a playground, restrooms, and a fishing pier.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish.

8. Bedford Boys Ranch, Bedford

- Excellent bank access.
- Park has picnic tables, walking trail, a playground, splash park, restrooms, and fishing piers.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish.

9. Lake Arlington, Arlington

- Major reservoir with limited bank access.
- Two parks with multiple fishing piers, picnic tables, and restrooms. Parks include Richard Simpson Park and Lake Arlington Park.
- Fish for largemouth bass, catfish, crappie, and sunfish.

10. Chisholm Park, Hurst

- Neighborhood Fishin' pond.
- Fish for catfish and rainbow trout.
- Tackle Loaner Site. Call (817) 788-7313 to request loaner tackle.

11. South Lakes Park, Denton

- Park has two ponds. North pond has sunfish, largemouth bass and catfish.
- Neighborhood Fishin' pond with fishing dock is close to playground. Fish for catfish and rainbow trout.

12. Lake Grapevine, Flower Mound

- Several parks offer abundant bank access for fishing, fishing piers, restrooms, campsites, and boat ramps. Parks include Marshall Creek Park, Meadowmere Park, Rockledge Park, Murrel Park, Oak Grove Park, Lake View Park, McPherson Slough Park, and Katie's Wood Park. Entrance fees may be required at parks or boat ramps.
- Fish for largemouth bass and catfish from the bank.

13. Lake Lewisville, Lewisville

- Several parks offer abundant bank access for fishing, fishing barge and piers, restrooms, picnic tables, campsites, and boat ramps. Parks include Arrowhead Park, Copperas Branch Park, Cottonwood Park, East Hill Park, Harbor Lane Park, Hickory Creek Park, Hidden Cove Park, City Lake Park, Little Elm Park, Oakland Park, Pilot Knoll Park, Stewart Creek Park, Sycamore Bend Park, Westlake Park, and Willow Grove Park.
- Fish for white bass, catfish, and carp.

14. LLELA, Lewisville

- Bank access and wadable fishing in the Elm Fork of the Trinity River below the Lake Lewisville Dam.
- Fish for white bass, catfish, carp, and rainbow trout (winter).

15. City Lake Park, Mesquite

- Neighborhood Fishin' pond.
- Fish for catfish and rainbow trout.

16. Joe Pool Lake, Cedar Hill

- Lots of parks and bank access.
- Fish for catfish and carp from the bank.

17. Benbrook Lake, Benbrook

- Several parks offer abundant bank access for fishing, fishing piers, restrooms, campsites, and boat ramps. Parks include Holiday Park, Mustang Park, Rocky Creek Park, Longhorn Park, and North Holiday Park. Entrance fees required at most parks.
- Fish for catfish and carp from the bank.

18. Lakeside Park, Duncanville

- Neighborhood Fishin' pond.
- Fish for catfish and rainbow trout.

19. Mike Lewis Park, Grand Prairie

- Park has a walking trail, playground, and restrooms.
- Rainbow trout stocked in winter.

20. Cliff Park, Dallas

- Park has a walking trails, a playground, picnic tables, pavilion, and restrooms.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish.

21. Bachman Lake, Dallas

- Major reservoir with excellent bank access.
- Park has walking/exercise trail, picnic tables, a pavilion, and restrooms.
- Fish for largemouth bass and crappie.

22. White Rock Lake, Dallas

- Major reservoir with excellent bank access.
- Park has walking/exercise trail, picnic tables, pavilions, fishing piers, kayak rental facilities, and restrooms.
- Fish for largemouth bass and crappie.

23. Phelps Lake, Rockwall

- Abundant bank access with a fishing pier.
- Fish for largemouth bass and sunfish.
