All males from eighteen (18) and less than twenty-six (26) years of age must provide proof that they have either registered with the selective services system or have been exempted from such registration prior to beginning state employment. This requirement pertains to all categories of potential employees—regular, temporary, intern, or seasonal. This procedure is in compliance with Section 651.005 of the Texas Government Code.
