- **Addenda** will be posted to the TPWD and ESD websites. If addenda are issued, Offeror must acknowledge receipt of addenda prior to the time and date specified in the receipt of responses to the solicitation. **Failure to do so may cause rejection of proposal.**

BID SUBMITTALS:

- ✓ Submit the original signed Bid schedule.
- ✓ Bid Schedule is structured as follows:
 - **Base Bid Item No. 1: Project No. 1110127** – Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary for mobilization included but not limited to securing bonds and insurance, establishing and removal of any necessary project facilities, movement of personnel, movement of equipment & supplies, cleanup of project site, and all other project incidentals necessary to complete the project in accordance with the Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.
 - **Base Bid Item No. 2: Project No. 1110127** – Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary erosion control, includes completion and submission of SW3P, NOI, and NOT. Includes all documentation. Also includes, but is not limited to equipment, labor, and hauling necessary to repair any erosion that occurs during the project construction process. Also includes supplying all materials, equipment, labor, tools, and incidentals necessary for installation, replacement, inspection, maintenance, and final removal of erosion control measures necessary to complete the project in accordance with the Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.
 - **Base Bid Item No. 3: Project No. 1110127** – Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary to demolish and remove all materials not salvaged by TPWD which may include concrete, dirt and other material and items in accordance with Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.
 - **Base Bid Item No. 4: Project No. 1110127** – Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary for restoration and clean-up of all disturbed areas including, damaged pavement restoration complete in place, and ready for service in accordance with Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.
 - **Base Bid Item No. 5: Project No. 1110127** – Provide a price for each Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary for pond liner demolition and installation including demolition of all existing liner(s), required installation of new liner including all liner testing and certifications, installation of liner, and hardware necessary for installation. Including all fittings, equipment, incidentals, excavation, bedding, compaction, flowable/CLSM, backfilling, surface restoration, materials, labor & superintendence, and testing necessary to install the line complete in place, and ready for service in accordance with Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.

- **Base Bid Item No. 6: Project No. 1110127** – Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary to install underdrain piping including scanning concrete kettle to locate existing rebar, coring kettle, laying underdrain, complete in place and ready for service, including all fittings, equipment, incidentals, excavation, bedding, compaction, thrust blocking, backfilling, surface restoration, materials, labor & superintendence , and testing necessary to install the line complete in place, and ready for service in accordance with Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.
- **Base Bid Item No. 7: Project No. 1110127** – Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and incidentals necessary for replacement of up to one hundred (100) stainless steel batten anchor bolts to complete liner installation including all work and equipment necessary for proper installation of the bolt in accordance with the Invitation for Bids and Contract Documents.
- **Unit Price Item: Project No. 1110127** – Provide a price per bolt to furnish all labor, equipment, materials and incidentals necessary for replacement of stainless steel batten bolts in excess of the one hundred (100) supplies under the Base Bid item.

- ✓ **Contractor’s Qualification Statement** – all requested information to be fully completed and legible.
- ✓ **Historically Underutilized Business Subcontracting Plan (HSP).** Submit an original and **one (1) identical copy of your HSP.**
- ✓ **Bid Security** (scanned copy) – 5% bond, certified or cashier’s check

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum Qualifications – Instructions to bidders Paragraph 13 as follows:

CONTRACTOR MUST SHOW EVIDENCE OF THREE (3) SUCCESSFUL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS SIMILAR TO THIS PROJECT (AS JUDGED BY OWNER) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AWARD OF THIS CONTRACT. THIS EXPERIENCE MUST HAVE OCCURRED WITHIN THE PAST (5) YEARS, MEASURED BACKWARDS FROM THE ISSUE DATE OF THIS SOLICITATION.

Projects similar in size and scope to the work required by this Contract are preferred.

OVERVIEW OF THE CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT:

- ❑ Prevailing Wages (Article 2 – Uniform General Conditions (UGC))
- ❑ Liquidated Damages - The sum of \$339.22 per calendar day has been set as a reasonable estimate of just compensation to the Owner if Contractor does not complete the work by the completion date. (Section 01000, Special Conditions, Paragraph 1.12 and Article 9, UGC)
- ❑ Performance Bond (Article 5 - UGC)
- ❑ Payment Bond (Article 5 - UGC)
- ❑ Certificate of Insurance (Article 5 – UGC)
- ❑ **HB1295 CERTIFICATE OF INTERESTED PARTIES:** In accordance with 2252.908 of the Government Code, the awarded Contractor(s) must use the Texas Ethics Commissions Application to enter the required information on Form 1295.
