### OBJECTIVE(S):

To acquire and set aside a Bone Cave harvestman habitat preserve by acquiring in fee an approximately 40-acre Round Rock Independent School District (RRISD) Tract in Williamson County.

### Summary of Progress:

Williamson County closed August 15, 2006, on the purchase of the Beck Preserve using the majority of the grant funds awarded to the County. The County explored with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service the possibility of using the remainder of the grant funds for purchase of additional acreage adjacent to the Beck Preserve. The County sought and received contract extension in connection with the RRISD/Beck Preserve grant to allow more time for continued dialogue with the Service and the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, and the completion of additional work. The County did not pursue the purchase of the additional acreage adjacent to the Beck Preserve prior to expiration of the grant period October 31, 2008.
