There has not been significant activity from the City in terms of meeting the grant's objective because of delays receiving a counter proposal from Clarke-Wyndham, Inc. for purchase the greenway area. The City did come to an impasse with the property owner regarding price. A request for an extension to the grant Period was made and granted to October 31, 2006 to allow time for planning and future action.

## Deviations:

Regrettably, this grant activity has been stalled for some time due to a number of factors that include an unwilling seller, turnover of City staff, and lack of coordination between Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and City on activities conducted. The City's contact for this grant, Kristan Weaver, resigned October 20, 2005. The contact replacement is Mark Smith (msmith@cstx.gov). A meeting will be coordinated with interested parties in the very near future to get this project moving forward, and to make sure the City is in compliance with the Federal program.
