NASP (National Archery in the Schools Program) was created in 2002 by the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources to address the lack of archery in physical education classes in public schools. The motto: "Changing lives one arrow at a time" was born. Educators thought that if school-aged children were exposed to archery in their PE classes, then those same children would want to pursue the sport later in life. On average, 66% of NASP students are first time archers.

Archery was introduced in Texas schools in 2004 by Steve Hall, a retired Texas Parks and Wildlife Hunter Education Manager. Hall wanted to give school-aged kids, who might otherwise never have the chance, the opportunity to try a sport that is accessible to anyone, regardless of gender, age, or ability. That same year, Texas held its first ever NASP State Tournament at the Mayborn Civic Center in Temple TX. That inaugural tournament hosted 126 student archers from 13 schools.

In 2016, a non-profit partnership with the Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation (OTF) brought about the growth of the Texas NASP State Tournament. OTF began in 1981 as the Dallas Ecological Foundation. Their primary purpose was to expand youth outdoor education and to help further efforts for wildlife conservation. Partnering with OTF allowed Texas NASP to enter more schools and engage more Texas children. It also allowed for more scholarships to be awarded to top archers for higher education. OTF is now the proud host of the Texas NASP State Tournament, having TPWD and NASP as event facilitators.

2016 also brought the introduction of the 3D component to the State Tournament. The 3D component consisted of archers shooting at foam targets modeled after six different North American game animals. 3D archery gave the students a chance to connect target archery to bowhunting in a fun and safe way. With the new introduction, archers could now compete in two categories: Bullseye and 3D.

Aside from the state tournament, schools across Texas have seen over 73,000 students take part in archery as part of their PE class curriculum. More and more schools are bringing archery to their students as part of the TEKS state standard as an application of a Lifetime Wellness activity. Archery has been identified as a pursuit most kids enjoy, as it does not limit accessibility due to lack of ability. Texas NASP sees the merit of implementing archery into the school curriculum to include more kids in sports and the outdoors, a great way to expose young Texas children to fun and fitness.

Over the last 19 years, the State Tournament has seen approximately 50,000 students, in grades 4th through 12th, walk onto the competition floor. An impressive \$400,000 in scholarship funds have been awarded to Texas students for higher education. This is only the beginning. Great things are on the horizon for Texas NASP.



During this 2025-26 school year, we will be celebrating the 20th anniversary of the Texas NASP State tournament. Thanks to the dedication of our partners, along with the hard work of coaches, parents, and volunteers, the tournament continually sets new participation records across the State of Texas, and the country. Since its inception, the tournament has experienced consistent and exponential growth each year, and TX NASP believes 2025 will be no exception.

Last year the State Tournament hosted over 5,100 student archers representing 250 schools' - a big leap from 18 short years ago. A total of \$48,000 dollars were awarded in scholarship funds to the top male and female high school archers. In addition, Texas was represented by 726 student archers who qualified to compete at the NASP 2025 National Tournament. These tournament participation numbers demonstrate that archery is no longer just a sport for hunters. If we create a space for archers to compete, then it's a sport open to whomever wishes to try.

The pledge to have as many kids participate at the State Tournament is at the forefront of the commitment that OTF, NASP and TPWD have made to all Texas schools. The move to the Freeman Coliseum was the first step in fulfilling that commitment.



Our biggest advertising push will begin in January and run through March 2026. On the day of the event, sponsors will be announced during the announcer's speech, banners will be on display, and student archers will receive a registration goodie bag that will have all sorts of treats and marketing material from our sponsors.
