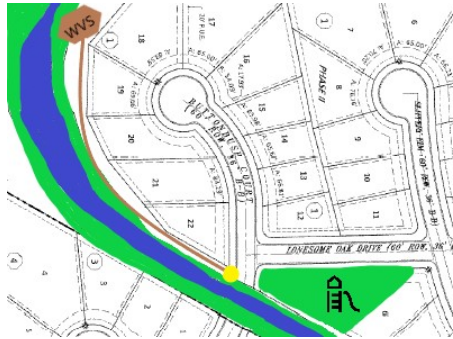


WILDWOOD TRAIL

Nolanville Trail Connectivity Project
Phase 1 of Wildwood Greenway



What is Wildwood Trail?

Wildwood Trail will be a natural walking path in Nolanville where visitors can immerse themselves in nature, observe wildlife, and learn about conservation.

The 0.10-mile trail will begin in Wildwood Estates and meander along a wet-weather channel to a Wildlife Viewing Station (WVS) overlooking a natural wetlands area. Visitors will be able to view native plants, birds, and other animals from the WVS platform.

The Wildwood Trail project also seeks to restore the wetlands area to its natural state by controlling erosion and reestablishing native plants. A more robust natural area will draw more birds and other animals for visitors to observe. We will maintain a clear trail and install signage to address safety concerns for neighbors and visitors.

Future additions and improvements to the trail include guided nature walks, interpretive signage, and a natural playground.
