




U.S. White-tailed Deer Population Estimate




Wild Turkey U.S. Population Estimate




Pronghorn U.S. Population Estimate





Recovering America's Wildlife Act (RAWA)

H.R. 4647, S. 3223



- Federally allocates up to \$1.3B
 annually from existing revenues
 into Wildlife Conservation
 Restoration Program
- \$63 M to Texas
- Dedicated to implement State Wildlife Action Plans
