Youth Only Squirrel and Deer: See TPWD Outdoor Annual for Special Youth Season Information and Regulations. See Legal Game Box for White-tailed Deer bag limit and legal buck requirements.

Youth and Veteran/Active-Duty Military Only Waterfowl: See TPWD Outdoor Annual for Special Season information and regulations. Shooting hours end at noon.

NOTE: Do not drive past pipeline road when wet. Pipeline maintenance road is restricted to foot traffic only. The area not contained in Public Hunting Area is private property and not accessible to permittees. Department personnel will have signs posted on-site.

OSR Required Each Day

White-tailed Deer: Bag limit - 1 buck and 1 antlerless. Legal buck must have at least one unbranched antler or an inside spread of 13 inches or greater. Hunting is allowed each day of the Archery, General, and Muzzleloader Seasons as established for Robertson County.

Feral Hog: (no bag limit)

Archery Season: Concurrent with established archery deer season for Robertson County.

General Season: Beginning with established general deer season for Robertson County and ending March 31.

Waterfowl: Shooting hours - one half hour before sunrise to noon, except all day hunting is allowed for Early Teal. Hunting is allowed each day of the **Early Teal**, **North Zone Duck**, and **Eastern Zone Goose** seasons (including any special conservation season).

Squirrel: As established for Robertson County.

Woodcock, Rail, Gallinule and Snipe

Dove: Each day of Central Zone Dove season.
