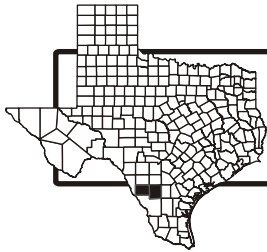

### LEGAL GAME • 2023-2024

**ALL PUBLIC USERS MUST REGISTER AT THE AREA HEADQUARTERS.**  
**NOTE:** Only the following species are legal to hunt and only on the dates designated below. Hunters are limited to the first 150 persons registered per day.  
**Dove:**  
**Special Season:** Sept. 1-3, Sept. 8-10.  
**Regular Season:** Sept. 14-17, Sept. 28-Oct. 1, Oct. 5-8.  
**Falconry Season:** Concurrent with dates for regular dove and quail season.  
**Quail:** Oct. 28-29, Jan. 6-7, Jan. 30-31, Feb. 6-7. Shooting hours are ½ hour before sunrise to sunset.  
**Rabbits & Hares:** Concurrent with hunt dates and times for dove and quail, including youth hunts (no bag limit).

### Special Season

**Youth/Adult Quail:** Oct. 21-22. Each party of 4 persons must have at least 1 youth under 17 years of age to participate. Hunters are limited to the first 150 persons registered per day.

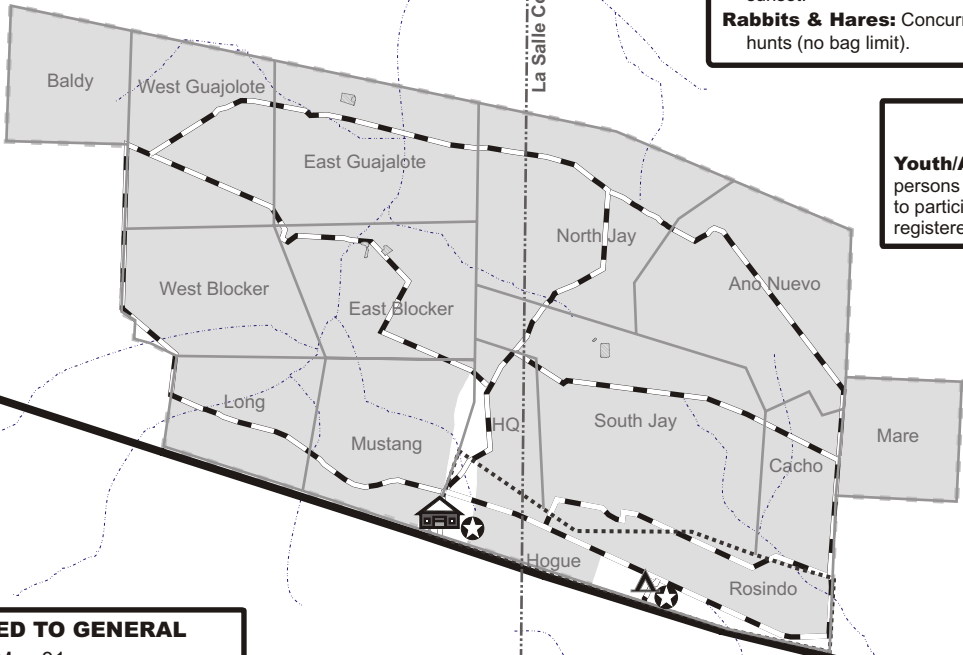

No general seasons for big game. All deer, javelina, and feral hog hunts are by drawn special permit only. See the Public Hunt Draw System on the TPWD website for more information.

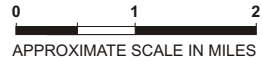

**ENTIRE AREA CLOSED TO GENERAL PUBLIC USE:** Sep. 1-Mar. 31.

**SPECIAL REGULATIONS:** Falconers must visibly wear a minimum of 400 square inches of daylight fluorescent orange material, with at least 144 square inches appearing on both the chest and the back and orange headwear. **All shotgun hulls, shell boxes and other trash must be retrieved from the field by hunters and disposed of off the WMA.** Portions of the Chaparral WMA will be closed due to ongoing Mineral Activities or Research on the Area. Such closures are necessary for safety reasons but will be limited by staff to provide as quality an experience as possible. Removing plants, shed antlers, artifacts, skulls, and/or live animals is prohibited. Killing of rattlesnakes or any other wildlife species other than legal game animals is prohibited. The use of ATV/ORVs is prohibited. The use of horses is prohibited. Overnight access is limited to the designated campsites ONLY. **Open period for general public use on the WMA is Apr. 1 - Aug. 31** and is limited to the area designated on the area map (Hogue & Rosindo Pastures Only). On-site Registration is required at the Area Headquarters or Camping Area Kiosk for all visitors year-round. No permit required for the Driving or Walking trails. Other visitation by appointment is available for educational groups, field days, or special interest.
