- Refuge Boundary: Entry permitted in accordance with refuge regulations
- Closed Area: All entry prohibited
- No Hunting Zone: Hunting, weapons, and game retrieval prohibited

Prohibited Activities


activities are prohibited while scouting or hunting: By law, recreational activities on national wildlife refuges are prohibited unless expressly permitted. The following

- Exceeding the posted refuge speed limit of 25 mph or less
- The take or harassment of any plant or animal species not listed on this permit
- Possession or use of dogs, and the possession or use of alcoholic beverages or drugs
- Marking or flagging any tree or refuge feature in any way
- Permanent tree stands, nails, screw-in steps, or other items that penetrate the outer bark of a tree
- Use of artificial lights and cameras to locate, observe, or take animals; and the use of drones or aircraft
- The use of natural vegetation to make or augment hunting blinds or stands
- Possession or distribution of bait, or hunting over bait

Use of, or hunting from, any type of watercraft or floating device

- Use of motorized or electric carts or wagons
