



Elephant Mountain WMA Guided Exotic Hunt

Hunting Information

You will be notified by the hunt manager with details about the hunt. TPWD staff will guide the hunt. Lodging and on-site transportation will be provided for this hunt. A grocery store and numerous restaurants can be found in Alpine, Texas, 26 miles North of the WMA. Hunters should plan to provide for their own meals and will have access to the kitchen and facilities in the Big House.

Hunters are reminded to bring water, ammunition, flashlight, foul weather gear, etc.

Disturbance or removal of plants, rocks, artifacts, or other objects is prohibited.

Hunters are reminded that they must have a valid Texas Hunting License, as required by statute. Hunters 17 years of age and older must have in their possession a valid I.D. Texas Hunter Education certification is required of Texas hunters born on or after September 2, 1971 (see the Texas Parks & Wildlife Outdoor Annual for more information).

Accommodations for hunters with disabilities on public hunt sites vary between areas. If you would like to request accommodation, please contact each area directly at least 2 weeks in advance of your hunt to discuss the options that may be available.

It is an offense for a person to be under the influence of alcohol or consume an alcoholic beverage while engaged in hunting activities or to publicly consume or display an alcoholic beverage while on the Area.
