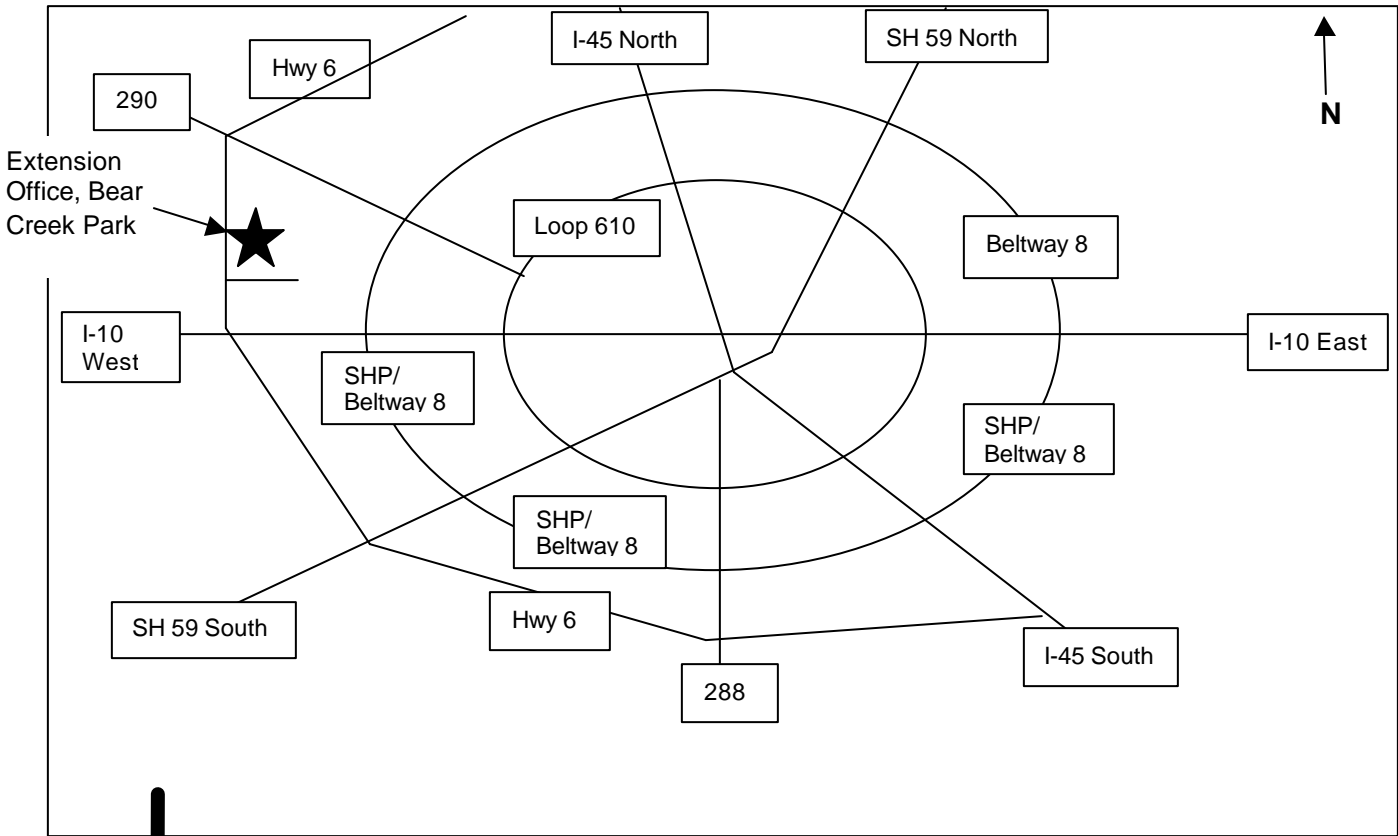

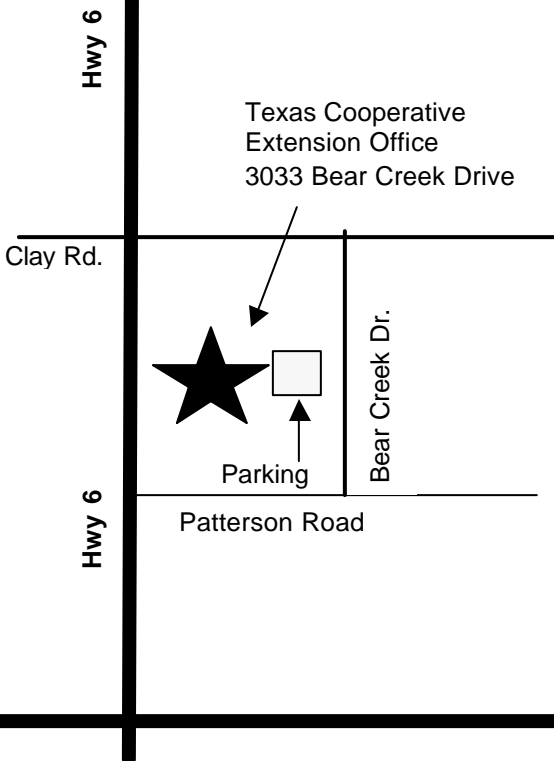

From North: You can take FM 1960 west. FM1960 becomes Hwy 6. OR Take I-45 or Hwy 59 south to the Sam Houston Parkway (Tollroad) or Beltway 8 (free). Take the SHP west until you reach Hwy 290. Take Hwy 290 West toward Austin. Exit Hwy 6. Turn left (south) on Hwy 6. Pass several main streets. Pass Clay Rd. Pass Keith Harrow Rd. Turn left (east) on Patterson Rd. Turn left on Bear Creek Drive. Extension office is on your left with large parking lot.

From East: Take I-10 west through downtown Houston, continue until you get to Hwy 6. Exit on Hwy 6 and turn right (north) on Hwy 6. Cross bridge. At Patterson Rd., turn right (east). Turn left on Bear Creek Rd. Extension office is on your left with large parking lot.

From South: Take Hwy 59 or 288 north to Hwy 6. Exit Hwy 6 and go west. Pass I-10. Turn right (east) at Patterson Rd. Turn left on Bear Creek Rd. Extension office is on your left with large parking lot.

From West: Take I-10 to Hwy 6. Exit Hwy 6 and go north on Hwy 6. Turn right (east) on Patterson Rd. Turn left on Bear Creek Rd. Extension office is on your left with large parking lot.
