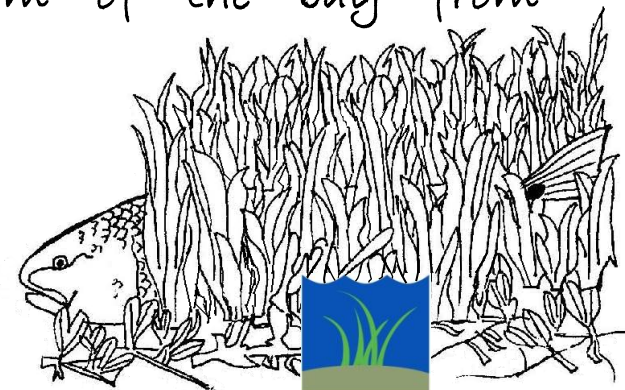
Seagrass absorbs sunlight for food and energy. This is how seagrass grows and stays healthy.
