LARGEMOUTH & SMALLMOUTH BASS
5 per day, any combo | minimum 14 inches*




STRIPED & HYBRID STRIPED BASS
5 per day, any combo | minimum 18 inches*



CRAPPIE
25 per day, any combo | minimum 10 inches*



CHANNEL & BLUE CATFISH
25 per day, any combo | minimum 12 inches*



GUADALUPE & SPOTTED BASS
5 per day, any combo | no minimum length



WHITE BASS
25 per day | minimum 10 inches




SUNFISH
no daily limit | no minimum length



RAINBOW TROUT
5 per day | no minimum length

HOW TO MEASURE



MEASURE TOTAL LENGTH WITH TAIL FIN COMPRESSED

1. Place the fish on its side with the jaw closed.
2. Squeeze the tail fin together to obtain the maximum overall length.
3. Measure a straight line from the tip of the snout to the extreme tip of the tail fin.




