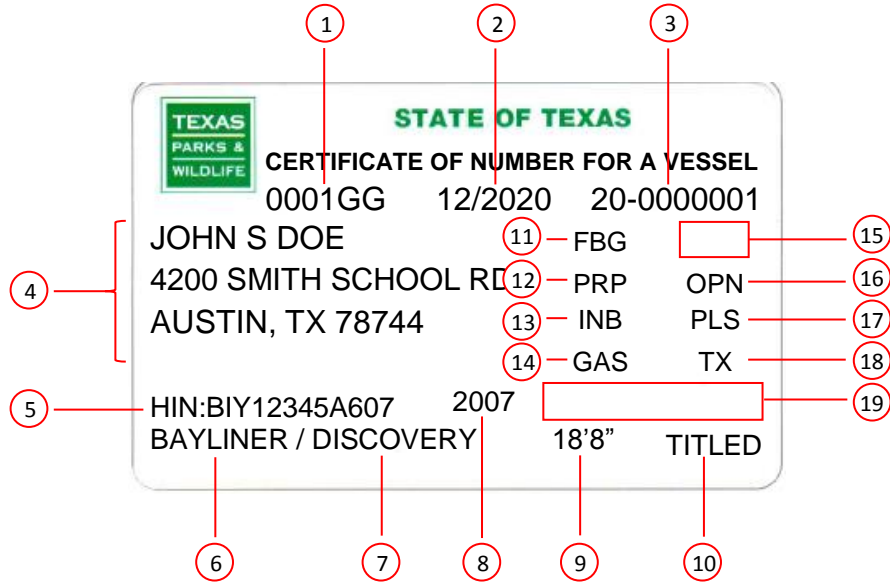




# State of Texas Certificate of Number for a Vessel ID Card

1. Certificate of Number or "TX Number" assigned & affixed to the vessel.
2. Registration expiration date (MM/YYYY). Expires the last day of the month shown.
3. Registration decal number. Number must match decals affixed to either side of vessel hull.
4. Name and address of owner of record. (Co-owners are not listed on card.)
5. Hull Identification Number (HIN).
6. Make
7. Model
8. Model Year
9. Length
10. Title Status "TITLED" or "NO-TTL" (non-titled)
