



San Marcos Lower River Underwater Cleanup

Contractor shall perform services for SCUBA cleanup as follows:

- Contractor shall supply labor, equipment, and transport of collected litter.
- Contractor will utilize 4 staffers per cleanup using 2 staffers as surface support and 2 divers underwater alternating to provide up to 4 dives per cleanup for maximum collection. Only 2 divers in the water at a time to minimize poor visibility.
- Contractor will send representative down river for inspection after cleanup or during.
- Coverage area starting 150 yards up from bridge at HWY 101 to 1000 ft
 past Last Business Exit on San Marcos River, and focusing on major
 hotspots for litter collection. These major collection points will be
 identified for staff to start down stream of each point and work up river
 to avoid causing worse visibility plus maximizing collection.
- Contractor will perform underwater cleanups from May 1 September 15 on weekly basis, and once a month from October – April. During this scope of project 27 cleanups will be performed with 4 staff members alternating which will total 108 dives for the season.
- Contractor will be using surface air equipment for performing maximum litter removal, and will have additional equipment on hand as needed.
- Contractor will separate collected litter and haul to a recycling facility.
- · Contractor will document cleanup with photos and a weekly log.
- This proposal does not constitute a contract between the parties in any
 way. Non-acceptance of any proposed contract on the part of Pristine
 Texas Rivers based on non-pricing issues (e.g. compliance penalty
 criteria, lack of clear contractual payment obligations and schedule) will
 result in immediate voidance of all aspects of pricing contained in this
 proposal
