

Application for Annual Party Boat Inspection

Review the <u>Annual Safety Inspection for Party Boats (PWD 1208B)</u> to ensure that your vessel can pass inspection on all categories. Submit the completed application and required fee to apply for an inspection. Once the application is processed, you will be provided with a receipt and a Texas Game Warden, or authorized inspector will contact you to schedule the vessel inspection and complete the Inspection Certificate.

What Boats Need This Inspection?

A party boat operated on the inland waters of Texas is subject to an annual safety inspection; requires the operator to be licensed and complete the required boat safety courses; imposes capacity limits on the number of passengers; and requires a minimum amount of liability insurance to be carried on the vessel.

A "party boat" is defined as a vessel operated by the owner, or an employee of the owner, and rented or leased for a group recreational event for more than six passengers.

This does not apply to:

- (1) a boat that is less than 30 feet in length;
- (2) a sailboat; or
- (3) any vessel used for training or instructional purposes while it is not being used as a party boat.

The annual water safety inspection is not required for a vessel carrying passengers for hire that has a Certificate of Inspection (COI) issued by the US Coast Guard. The COI is required for those vessels that operate on navigable (federal) waters by definition. If a vessel has such a document (required annually by the USCG), then a State COI is not required.

A complete listing of categories and items to be inspected can be found on the <u>Annual Safety Inspection for</u> <u>Party Boats (PWD 1208B)</u>. You are strongly recommended to review these items prior to requesting and paying for an inspection.
