- **Initial Amount** = Amount of fish in possession at the start of reporting period (Jan 1)
- **Amount imported/purchased** = Amount of fish imported or purchased during reporting period
- **Amount sold/transferred** = Amount of fish sold or transferred during reporting period
 - Tilapia (report **BOTH** number and pounds; estimate if one measure is unknown):
 - Fry: amount sold/transferred as fry; enter '0' if none
 - Fingerlings: amount sold/transferred as fingerlings; enter '0' if none
 - Mature fish: amount sold/transferred as mature fish; enter '0' if none
 - Triploid grass carp:
 - Sizes: note what size of triploid grass carp were sold
- **Amount lost** = Approximate amount of fish lost – give brief description of how fish were lost (e.g., fish died due to cold)
