## TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT <u>REVISED</u> EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ORDER NO. 10-002

In order to promote the public safety, the Executive Director of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department hereby ORDERS the following restrictions on the use of motor vehicles on the grounds of the State Headquarters:

The operator of a motor vehicle may not drive at a speed greater than the limits established in this Order.

The following speeds are lawful:

- No more than 30 miles per hour on the access road between the intersection with Smith School Road and the <u>end of Building A at the stop sign</u> (shown in blue on the attached diagram);
- No more than 20 miles per hour on the Parking Areas and on the access road between end of building A at the stop sign and the southern entrance to Parking Area C (shown in green on the attached diagram); and
- No more than 30 miles per hour on the entrance boulevard from McKinney Falls Parkway and the northernmost entrance to Parking Area A (shown in blue on the attached diagram).

The attached diagram is incorporated into this Order for all intents and purposes. HQ Police are hereby directed to post signs informing the public of these speed limits.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 13.0145 of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Code and Title 31, Tex. Admin. Code §59.132 (State Park Regulations) and is effective immediately.
