

**TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT  
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ORDER NO. 11-005**

The Executive Director of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department ORDERS that in addition to the regulations contained in the Public Lands Proclamation (31 TAC Chapter 65, Subchapter H), hunting on public lands in this state shall be conducted as provided for in the department publications entitled "2011-2012 Applications for Drawings on Public Lands," and "2011-2012 Map Booklet for Public Hunting Lands" and any supplements.

Due to resource concerns related to the exceptional drought and to continuing negative impacts resulting from the effects of Hurricane Ike, the Executive Director of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department also ORDERS the following modification to the department publication entitled "2011-2012 Applications for Drawings on Public Lands":

The number of drawn special permit general alligator hunt positions scheduled for the J. D. Murphree Wildlife Management Area is reduced from 180 positions to 98 positions.

This order is issued pursuant to §81.402 of the Texas Parks and Wildlife code and is effective immediately.
