

**TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT**

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ORDER NO. 012-001**

Pursuant to the requirements of Parks and Wildlife Code, §13.001 and the provisions of 31 Tex. Admin. Code §59.62, the Executive Director of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department hereby orders that the tracts of land enumerated herein be designated a state park and entered into the inventory of Texas Parks and Wildlife Department lands classified as state parks.

1. 1960.785 acres of land as described by metes and bounds in Volume 313, Page 604 of the Deed Records of Palo Pinto County;
2. 42.158 acres of land and all of a called 42.10 acres tract described in Volume 956 Pages 553 and 556 of the Official Public Records of Palo Pinto County;
3. 1330.185 acres tract of land in Palo Pinto and Stephens counties, described by metes and bounds in Volume 1737, Page 206 of the Official Public Records of Palo Pinto County and Volume 174, Page 254 of the Deed Records of Stephens County; and,
4. Two 40-foot roadways or strips of land described by metes and bounds in Volume 174, Page 254 of the Deed Records of Palo Pinto County.

This order is issued pursuant to §13.001 of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Code and 31 Tex. Admin. Code §59.62 and is effective immediately.
