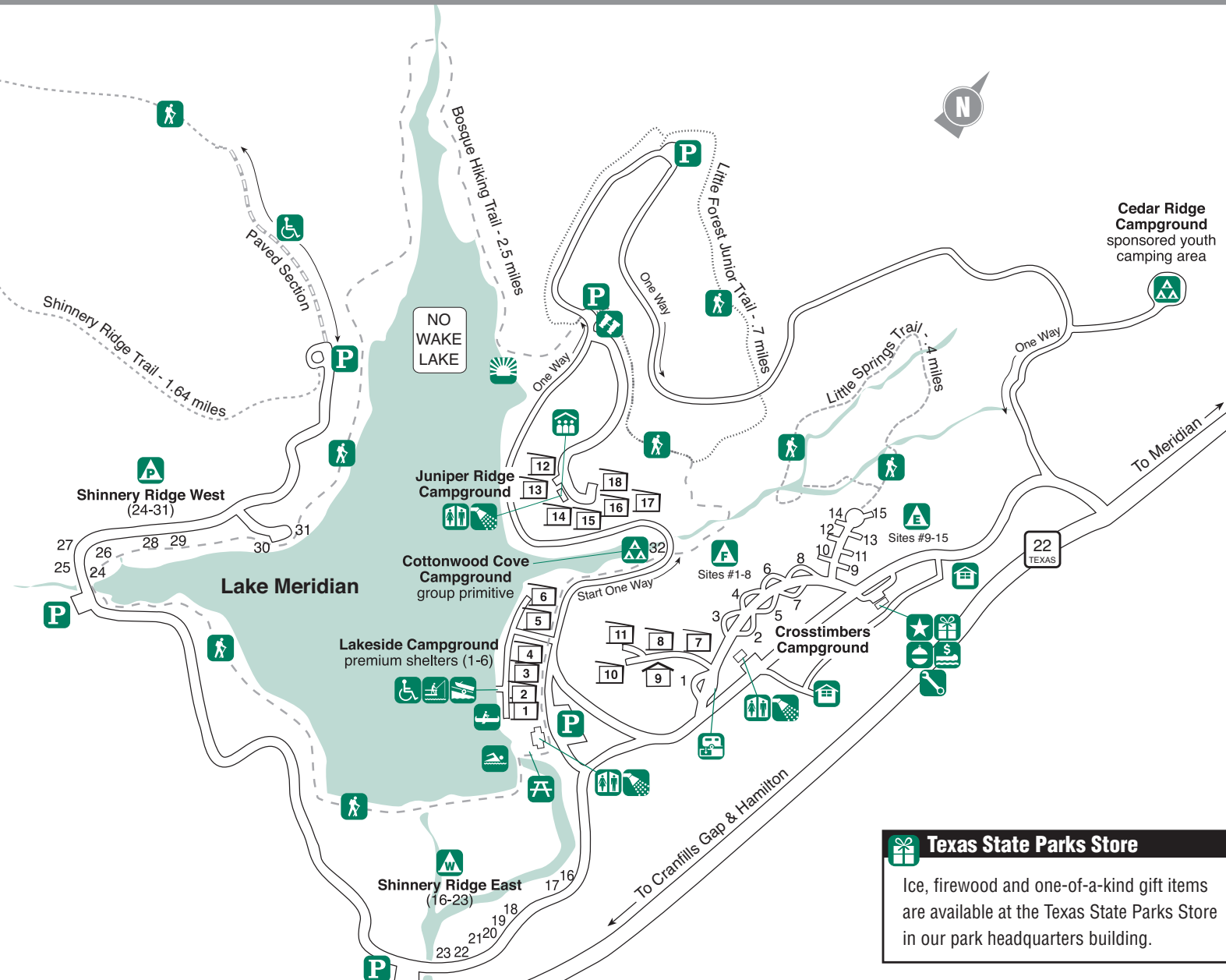




## PLEASE NOTE

- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. for campsites, 1 p.m. for cabin and shelters. Renew permit by 9 a.m. subject to availability.
- Public consumption or display of an alcoholic beverage is prohibited. All areas within this park are "public."
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only. **NO PICNICKING**
- Park and drive on paved surfaces only.
- Quiet hours are enforced from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. or at anytime a disturbance is created.
- Excess parking fee is required at campsites with more than two vehicles including trailers. All excess vehicles will be relocated to the overflow parking area.
- A maximum of eight people at any numbered campsite or shelter. All day-use visitors **MUST** leave the park prior to 10 p.m.
- No person shall use electrical speakers or radios at a volume which emits beyond their immediate campsite.
- No pets allowed in any park facility. Pets must not be left unattended or cause a disturbance.
- Gathering firewood prohibited.
- Swim at your own risk. **NO LIFEGUARD** on duty.
- Stop the spread of invasive species. **CLEAN, DRAIN and DRY** your boat.
