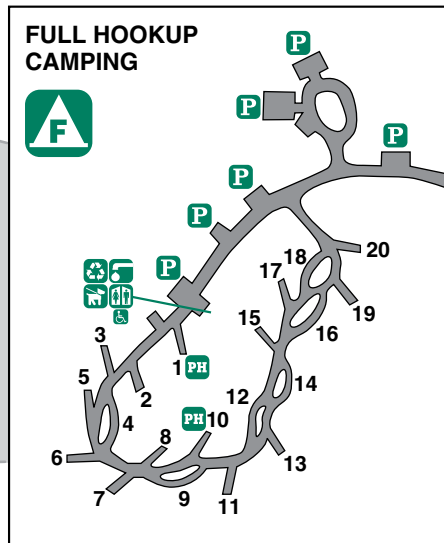

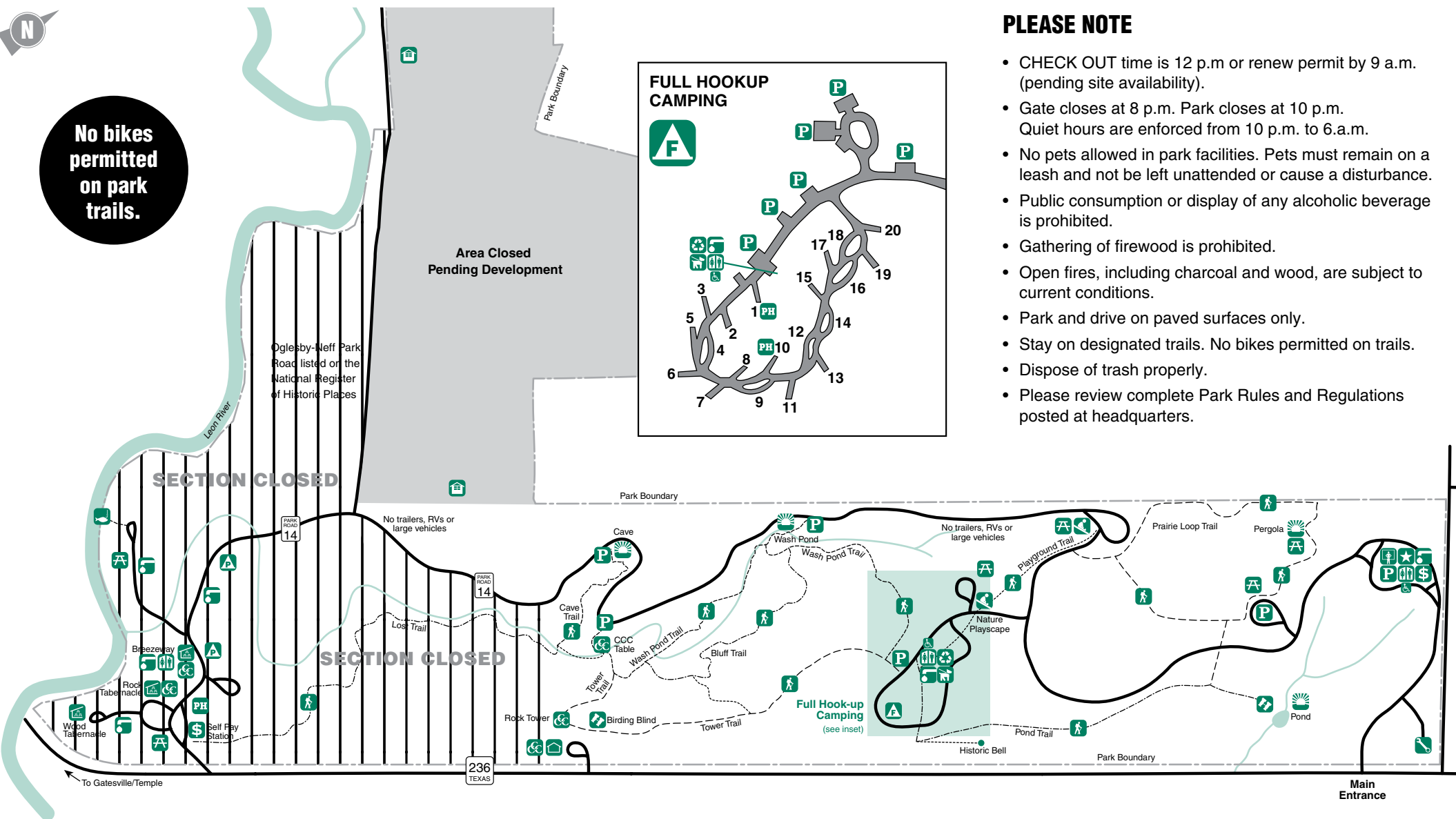

- Stay on designated trails. No bikes permitted on trails.
