### PLEASE NOTE

- Park hours – 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Campsite check-out – noon.
- Quiet hours – 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. (no music or generators).
- Maximum eight people per campsite.
- Discharge gray and black water at dump station.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- It is an offense to possess, display or discharge any firearm.
- Pets must be on a leash not exceeding six feet in length.
- All vehicles must remain on pavement.
- Gathering firewood prohibited.
- Possession or discharge of fireworks prohibited.
- Valid permit required on windshield of each vehicle.
- Numbered sites for overnight camping only.

### NOTE

Equine must have proof of a negative EIA (Coggins) test within the past 12 months. The form VS 10-11 is proof of testing.
