

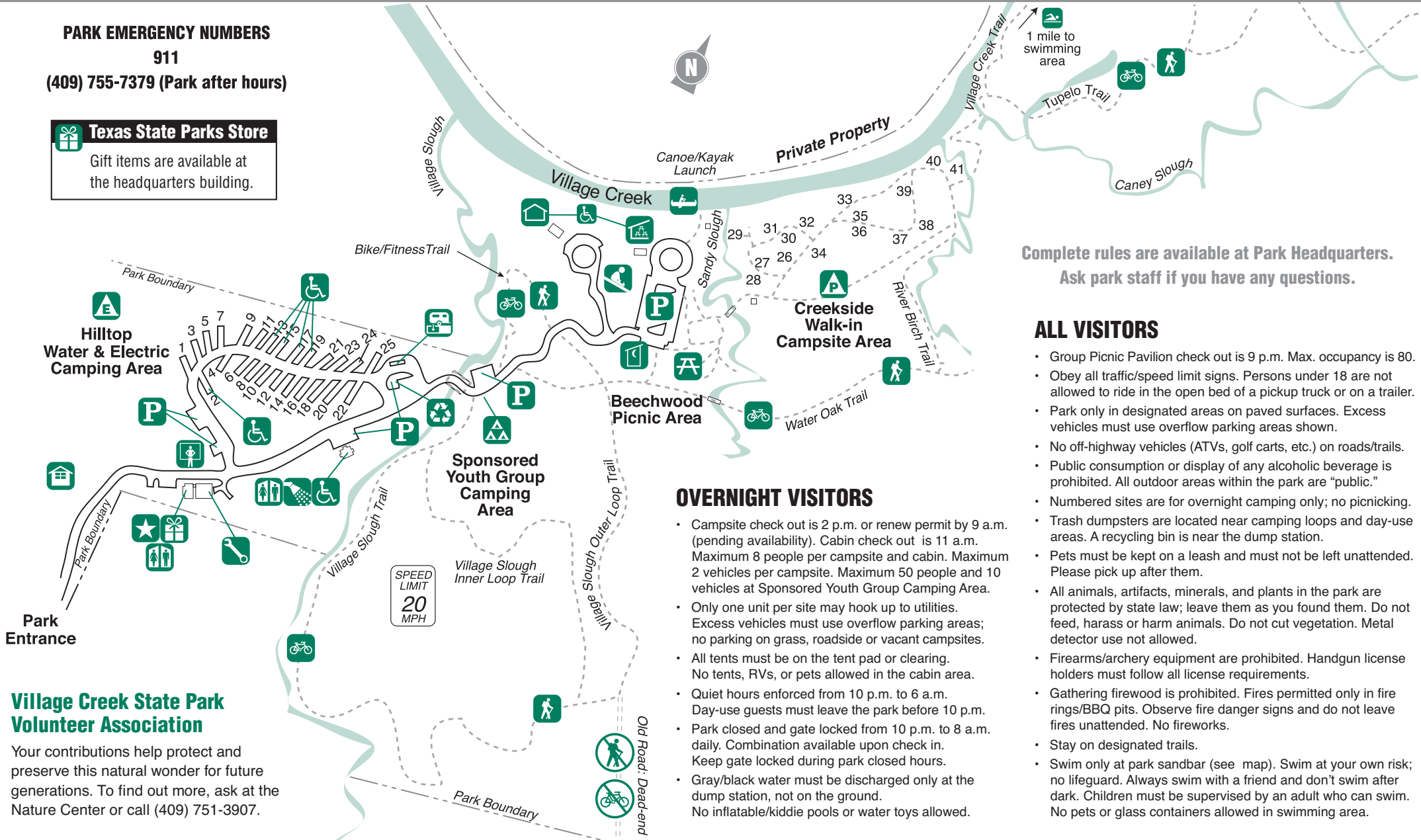

**ALL VISITORS**

- Group Picnic Pavilion check out is 9 p.m. Max. occupancy is 80.
- Obey all traffic/speed limit signs. Persons under 18 are not allowed to ride in the open bed of a pickup truck or on a trailer.
- Park only in designated areas on paved surfaces. Excess vehicles must use overflow parking areas shown.
- No off-highway vehicles (ATVs, golf carts, etc.) on roads/trails.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited. All outdoor areas within the park are "public."
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only; no picnicking.
- Trash dumpsters are located near camping loops and day-use areas. A recycling bin is near the dump station.
- Pets must be kept on a leash and must not be left unattended. Please pick up after them.
- All animals, artifacts, minerals, and plants in the park are protected by state law; leave them as you found them. Do not feed, harass or harm animals. Do not cut vegetation. Metal detector use not allowed.
- Firearms/archery equipment are prohibited. Handgun license holders must follow all license requirements.
- Gathering firewood is prohibited. Fires permitted only in fire rings/BBQ pits. Observe fire danger signs and do not leave fires unattended. No fireworks.
- Stay on designated trails.
- Swim only at park sandbar (see map). Swim at your own risk; no lifeguard. Always swim with a friend and don't swim after dark. Children must be supervised by an adult who can swim. No pets or glass containers allowed in swimming area.

**OVERNIGHT VISITORS**

- Campsite check out is 2 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending availability). Cabin check out is 11 a.m. Maximum 8 people per campsite and cabin. Maximum 2 vehicles per campsite. Maximum 50 people and 10 vehicles at Sponsored Youth Group Camping Area.
- Only one unit per site may hook up to utilities. Excess vehicles must use overflow parking areas; no parking on grass, roadside or vacant campsites.
- All tents must be on the tent pad or clearing. No tents, RVs, or pets allowed in the cabin area.
- Quiet hours enforced from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Day-use guests must leave the park before 10 p.m.
- Park closed and gate locked from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. daily. Combination available upon check in. Keep gate locked during park closed hours.
- Gray/black water must be discharged only at the dump station, not on the ground. No inflatable/kiddie pools or water toys allowed.
