PLEASE NOTE

- CHECK-IN time is 2 p.m. CHECK-OUT time is 12 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending availability).
- Park gate closes at 10 p.m. and will open again at 6 a.m. Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only. No picnicking.
- Campsites must be kept clean. Remove trash before leaving.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited. **NO GROUND FIRES.** Campfires are only permitted in the fire rings provided at each site. **Campfires are prohibited in Bristol Backcountry Campground.**
- Pets must be kept on a leash no longer than six feet. Pet waste must be cleaned up and properly discarded. No pets permitted in any buildings.
- Use caution near low water crossings and spillway. Watch for **FLASH FLOODING** at these locations.
- It is the visitor's responsibility to **KNOW** and **OBEY** all park rules and regulations which can be found at park headquarters.

ACTIVE RAILROAD

- Train passes on northern border day and night. Horn is **NOT** blown due to no railroad crossings.
- Practice good train etiquette by keeping a safe distance. **NEVER** wander onto or under railroad tracks.
- Note that railroad tracks are not on park property. Crossing park boundary line to reach tracks is **TRESPASSING**.



Accessibility

All buildings are ADA-compliant and have accessible parking. Restrooms and vault toilets are also accessible. Ask HQ staff about our other accessibility options.

TUCKER LAKE

- **NO GAS MOTORS.** Battery-run motors are permitted but must be operated at idle speed (no wake).
- Stop the spread of invasive species. **CLEAN, DRAIN, and DRY** your boat.
- Daily bag limit = 5 (**all species combined**) of which only 1 may be a black bass which must be 14 inches or greater in length.
- Limited shoreline available for fishing and swimming. **SHARE** the shore.
- No lifeguard. Swim at your own risk.
