# **Thank you for your support of the conservation license plate program.**

## **Do I have to wait until I get my renewal notice to order new plates?**

No, there's no need to wait until you receive your renewal notice; you can order your license plates at any time!

## **Can I put conservation license plates on my motorcycle, trailer or RV?**

Yes, all of the conservation license plates are available for trailers, travel trailers, motorcycles and RVs.

## **Where can I order one of these license plates?**

You can order plates either at your local county tax office or online at [www.ConservationPlate.org](http://www.ConservationPlate.org).

## **When will my license plate be ready?**

It will take two to three weeks to get your license plates after your order. If you order at your local tax office, the plates will be mailed to your home. If you order online, the plates will be mailed to your local county tax office where you can pick them up. Visit [www.ConservationPlate.org/taxoffice](http://www.ConservationPlate.org/taxoffice) to find your county tax office.

## **Are my vehicle registration fees included in the price of the Texas conservation license plates?**

No. Fees for your annual registration are not included.

## **Can I personalize my Texas conservation license plates?**

For an additional \$40 you may order personalized plates of five characters or fewer (four for motorcycles). TxDMV will review each request to ensure that it does not duplicate plates already assigned.
