Trail: Short hiking trail.



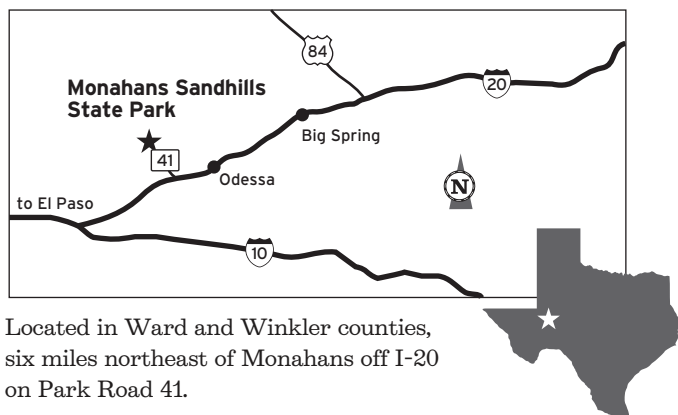
Equestrian Area: 600 sandy acres for riding.
