Mile-high on the slopes of the Davis Mountains is a rustic inn called Indian Lodge. Built in the 1930s by the Civilian Conservation Corps, this full-service hotel is modeled after southwestern Indian pueblos and has adobe walls more than 18 inches thick. After a full day of outdoor fun, relax by the pool, spend a peaceful night in one of the inn's rustic rooms and dine in comfort at the Black Bear Restaurant. One visit to Indian Lodge is sure to begin a family tradition!



Accommodations: 39 rooms, each with central air/heat, cable TV, telephone, hair dryer and coffee pot. No pets are allowed.



Group Facilities: Meeting rooms; catering available.



Black Bear Restaurant: Open for breakfast and lunch, Wednesday through Sunday.



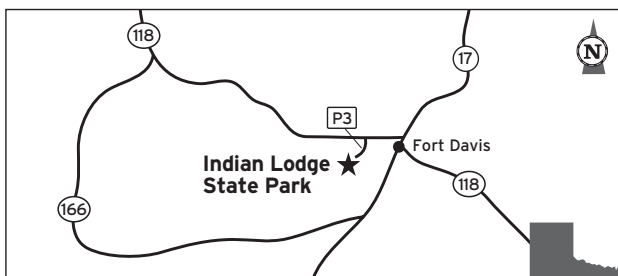
Swimming: Swimming pool.
