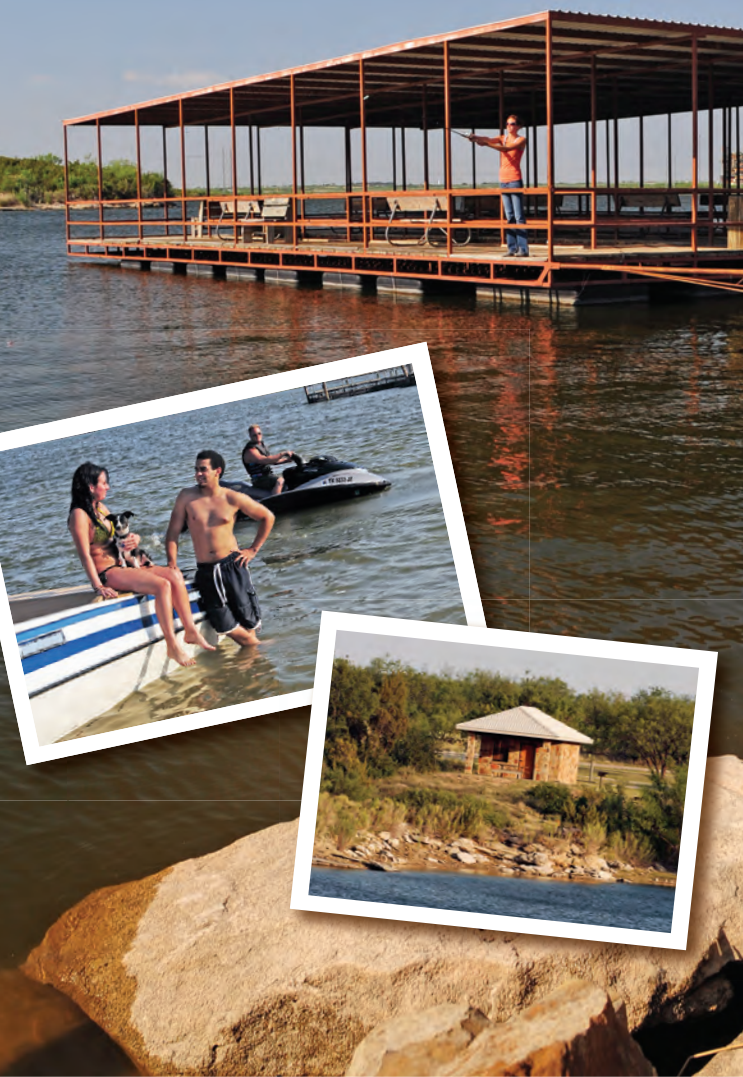

Camping: Campsites with water only or water/electricity. WiFi is available in some campsites.



Cabins: 11 limited-use cabins available.



Group Facilities: Group picnic pavilion (capacity 40). Group recreation hall (capacity 75).



Picnicking: Picnic sites.



Swimming: At your own risk in the lake.



Boating: Boat ramp, boating and water skiing.



Fishing: Fishing opportunities exist; pier and barge facilities. Contact the park for lake levels and other fishing info.



Hiking Trail: 1 mile.



Texas State Parks Store: T-shirts, books, firewood, etc.
