Swimming: at your own risk in lake.



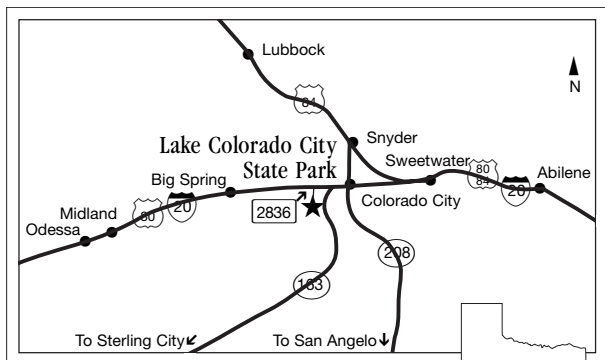
Boating: boating, water skiing. Boat ramp.
