Situated on the shores of a small lake, Purtis Creek State Park caters to fishing enthusiasts of all ages. Following its construction, the reservoir was stocked with Florida largemouth bass, channel catfish, coppernose bluegills, shad and redear sunfish. To ensure a pleasant fishing experience for everyone, only 50 motorized boats are allowed on the lake at one time and a no-wake rule is strictly enforced. Bass fishing is restricted to catch-and-release.



Camping: Campsites with water and electricity, water only, and primitive sites.



Picnicking: Picnic area with tables, covered pavilion and playground.



Swimming: Permitted in designated swimming area.



Boating: Boat ramp and dock.



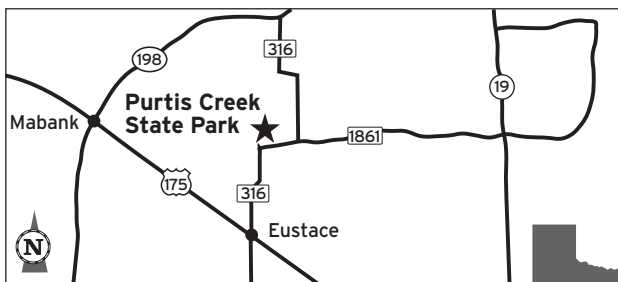
Fishing: Lighted fishing piers and fish cleaning stations.



Trails: A 2-mile nature hike to primitive camping area. Over 4 miles of hike/bike trails.



Texas State Parks Store: One-of-a-kind items, camping supplies and paddle-boat, kayak and canoe rentals.



Located in Henderson and Van Zandt counties. Take Texas 175 to Eustace, then north on Farm Road 316 for three miles to park entrance on left.
