# Legal White-tailed Bucks

*in antler restriction counties*

*(Refer to Outdoor Annual)*

A LEGAL BUCK DEER is defined as having a hardened antler protruding through the skin **AND**:

- at least one unbranched antler; **OR**
- an inside spread measurement between main beams of 13 inches or greater.

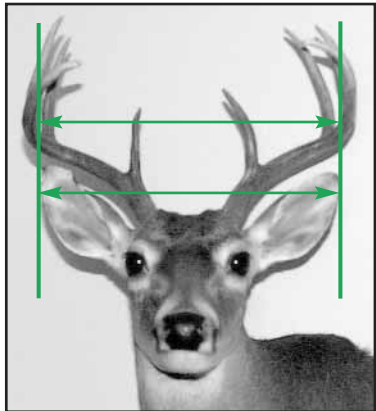
**Bag Limit Two Bucks:** No more than one buck may have an inside spread of 13 inches or greater.

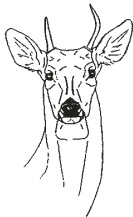


**How do you determine if a buck has an inside spread measurement of 13 inches or greater?**

The distance from ear-tip to ear-tip on a buck with ears in the alert position measures approximately 13 inches.

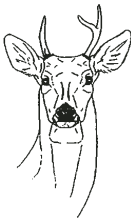
The inside spread on this buck is exactly 13 inches.





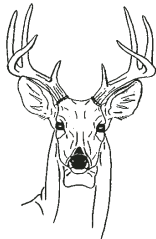

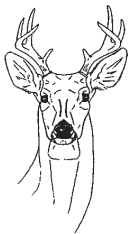

## DEFINITION OF A POINT



**LEGAL POINT**



**NOT A POINT**

A **point** is a projection that extends at least one inch from the edge of a main beam or another tine. The tip of the main beam is also a point.
