


Texas Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Program



Whether you ride dirt bikes, all-terrain vehicles or a 4x4 truck, an off-highway vehicle is a great way to spend time together outdoors with your family and friends. There are many exciting sites in Texas to ride and new sites are always opening. Many sites also offer hiking and camping which makes it easy to take the whole family along for an outdoors adventure. Our new web site www.tpwd.state.tx.us/ohv has an updated list of OHV recreation areas that are open to the public.

The Texas Off-Highway Vehicle Program makes it easier to find places to ride safely and to encourage more responsible use of the outdoors. The program will also provide funding to develop more recreational areas for OHV users. An OHV decal is required by law for all individuals operating an OHV in Texas in an area that is located on public land, or at OHV recreation areas that have been improved or purchased with TPWD OHV grants. A Texas OHV decal costs \$8 and is good through August 31 of the year it was purchased.

Revenue generated will be used to help create new or improve existing OHV recreation areas in Texas. A Texas OHV decal can be purchased with your credit card over the phone by calling (512) 389-8917 or you can purchase at select locations.
