FAQ's (SPECIAL EDITION: Game Warden Application Process)

Once I have submitted my application on NEOGOV, can I go back and update

**information?** Yes, you can make revisions on your online application and re-submit it upon completion. Once the application process ends the most recent version of your application will be utilized. However, please be thorough in your initial application and pay proper attention to detail to avoid multiple application submissions. Online applications can be saved throughout the course of the process without being submitted.

**Do I need to submit a resume?** No, a resume is not required to submit your application. A resume can be optionally attached online, however the presence of a resume does not further enhance your application.

**Do I need to send my official college transcript to apply?** No, a copied/scanned version of your official college transcript is initially sufficient online. If the applicant proceeds to the background investigation stage, a sealed official college transcript will be requested by their background investigator.

PLEASE NOTE: Applications for the position of Game Warden Cadet will be accepted until April 7, 2017. Due to the high influx of inquiries, we ask that you thoroughly review ALL game warden recruiting & career online links in their entirety prior to contacting a recruiter with a question.
